### The WEB Rule Book

- CUT OFF IS 8am on the dot, no more said.
- Strictly NO phone entries – you are responsible for getting your own name in the sign-in book.
- First heat will be in the water at 8.10am, so be prepared, it could be yours.
- Competitors should wait until they are assigned a heat and heat time before leaving contest area, e.g. to go for a surf, or get breakfast, etc.
- There are 8 point scoring competitions during the year – the best 6 of your results determine who gets the trophies.
- The dates shown on the calendar are what we've submitted to Gosford City Council. To prevent clashes with other events, Council expects us to abide by these dates. Basically if there is a rideable, safe wave we will be holding the comp
- The best two waves that you catch during your heat are added together and tallied against the other competitors – the placings of each heat are a result of tallying all three judging sheets.
- If a competitor hinders another surfers scoring potential it is deemed an interference – the offending surfer will lose “half their second best wave” and zero points will be awarded to that surfer for that particular wave.
- Keep beach clean – DO NOT leave your rubbish on or just under the sand, you will only paddle through it the next day.
- To avoid confusion, competitors of the previous heat must approach the beach laying down on their board.
- Don't surf in the competition area – if a free-surfer interferes with a competitor, the free-surfer will lose 150 points on the spot.

### Judging

- Experienced judges must invest time to train those that are not confident judging – encourage Grommies to spot for a couple of heats and learn by observation – judging will benefit your approach to surfing in competitions.
- Judges must sit near each other and communicate, frequently compare wave counts and make use of spotters.
- Denominations/increments of judging will remain at 0.5 – use full 0pt to 10pt scale.
- Try to judge at least 2 heats during the day.

Most importantly, we are a social club with a competition format for those that love trophies. Hang out at the beach, have some fun, have a yarn, grab a snag off the BBQ and then go tear it apart.
