A special note must be made that Sheriff Rudolf judged 11 heats, an outstanding effort, but wasn't present to collect the prize so it went to Lynchy.

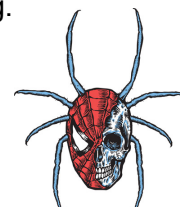
March Comp 3
